RESOLUTION 051820-F

AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF SURVEILLANCE CAMERA INSTALLATION THROUGH ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have agreed that said purchase will provide the Police Department with useful technology to increase safety and efficiency for the Alabaster Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alabaster Police Department wish to purchase the following:

- 25 – Flock Safety 5 MP License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras and all associated networking equipment
- Connection of power from solar panel on camera
- Dedicated 4G LTE network backhaul connection and hardware
- All required license fees and monthly subscription fees for 25 cameras using Flock’s LPR platform with standard 30-day storage

WHEREAS, said purchase of security equipment is exempt from bid law based on **Alabama Code Section 41-16-51 (a) (15)**; and

WHEREAS, the total of said **24-month contract** to include accessories is **\$100,002.00** with an Estimated Monthly Service Amount = **\$4,166.75** added to the City’s power bill beginning in October with NO upfront costs.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Police Department of the City of Alabaster be allowed to purchase 25 Flock Cameras, accessories and the service at a cost totaling \$102,000.00. (Exhibit A.)
2. The City Council also directs Mayor Marty B. Handlon and City Clerk, J. Mark Frey to execute any and all documentation necessary on behalf of the City to complete this transaction.


