## IMPORTANT DATES

- Secure your tree with payment of \$250.00 by Monday November 14, 2022.** Limited number of trees available.
- Tree selection** will be a first come first serve basis on **Wednesday, November 23rd from 9:00 am-4:00 pm.** Check in at table to receive signage to be placed by the tree location you “select”.
- Decorating of Trees** – begins on Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup> and must be completed no later than Thursday December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Lighting ceremony will be held December 2<sup>nd</sup>** in conjunction with the annual tower lighting at City Hall.
- All tree decorations must be removed by vendor no later than Thursday January 5<sup>th</sup>.** Trees and any remaining decorations will be discarded on Friday January 6<sup>th</sup>.  
**\*Note\* Any vendor that has not selected a tree on November 23<sup>rd</sup> will be assigned a tree location by the city.**

## LIGHTS - EXTENSION CORD

- Decorations and lights provided by the company or individual sponsoring the tree.
- Lights - maximum of 4 strings of lights allowed. **Lighting must be LED and inspected prior to use on tree selection day.** Lights should be strung with the male end the plug coming from the bottom of the tree.
- Extension cord to be labeled with company/sponsor name on it and must be an **outdoor rated extension cord.** Will be inspected prior to use on tree selection day

## DECORATION GUIDELINES

- Please remember decorations must withstand the weather elements outside with wind and rain.
- Zip-ties, pipe cleaners or string are recommended to secure decorations to the tree.
- You may want to consider bringing a step stool to decorate. Minimum height is a 6-foot tree.
- Edible items used to decorate the tree are prohibited of any kind.** It attracts wildlife and poses a safety issue.
- NO spray painting of trees on the property.**

**Please remember it’s a family event and any decorations found to be offensive will be removed by the City.**
